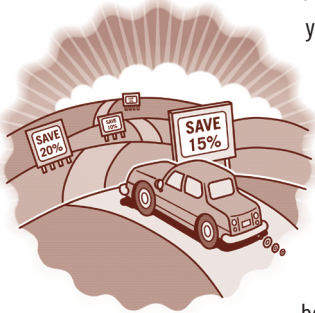

Who's eligible?

All dues-paying union members and their immediate families, as well as union retirees, are eligible for coverage. Adult unmarried children 26 or under who are attending school full time may be covered on their family plan. Married children and grandchildren are exempted, except grandparents may carry grandchildren when they are their legal guardians.

Questions & Answers

Who provides motor club services?

AFSCME Advantage has partnered with Drive America Motor Club to provide our motor club services. Drive America Motor Club has over 50 years experience providing motor club services to Ford, Landrover, CSEA, and many others. Their network includes over 27,000 independent service providers, and all phone calls are answered in the USA.

How do I enroll?

Union members can enroll themselves and their immediate family members by visiting www.afscme.org or calling **1-800-454-8722**. Enrollment can be paid by check, credit card, money order, monthly checking account drafts or monthly credit card drafts. Members should expect to receive their membership cards within 10-14 days of enrollment.

How do I know if I'm getting a good value?

Visit www.afscme.org and compare head to head on services and value. AFSCME Advantage Motor Club provides comparable services at a much lower price.

How many emergency roadside assistance calls are included each year?

Each year of membership in AFSCME Advantage Premier Motor Club includes a maximum of three auto service calls.

What is the out-of-pocket cost for an emergency service call?

Roadside assistance and locksmith services are included up to \$125 per call. The member is responsible for charges over \$125.

What if the member isn't driving? Am I still covered?

AFSCME Advantage Motor Club covers the member as a driver or passenger in virtually any vehicle.

Will emergency roadside service always be provided within 45 minutes?

AFSCME Advantage Motor Club cannot guarantee a 45-minute on the scene response for every location. But with 27,000 independent service providers nationwide, members can be confident knowing that assistance is on the way.

Does this plan only include cars and trucks?

Yes, only cars and trucks are covered. However, most vehicles are covered, and the year, make and model do not affect your eligibility or rate.

Are all the basic services included in my low membership rate?

Your low rate includes all of the following:

- ★ Emergency travel services
- ★ \$1,000 in travel assistance, including car rental, lodging, meals and more, when the vehicle you are driving or riding in is stolen or disabled due to an accident
